

Westwood Academy PE Premium Report

From September 2013 the Government allocated funding to all primary schools to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision. Schools are free to decide how this funding is spent to enhance outcomes for children. In 2012/13 Westwood Academy was allocated £8910 and the same amount was allocated in 2014/15. Below is a completed action plan for 2013/14 (to show how the Pupil premium grant was spent and its impact) and an action plan for 2014/15 to set out intended actions and intended impact.
