# Home Learning, Westwood Academy Reception

Good morning,

I hope you are all well.

It is great to see so many of you doing home learning each week, please remember this isn't compulsory and your child's wellbeing is more important at this time. We will be welcoming more children back next week and our priority at school will be on children's wellbeing and safety. It looks like it will be three or four groups with the amount of children returning, giving your child three or four days in school over the final three weeks of term. This time will be used to help support the children's transition into Year 1.

For Phonics this week, we are still learning to read and write Phase 4 Phonics blends containing digraphs. This week, the blend is at the beginning of the word, instead of the end, which we were learning last week. This week children are learning about the lifecycle of a Sea Turtle. Each day, children can research with an adult and write about a different part of a turtle's life. Please encourage the children to use their phonics sounds to sound out each word they write, for their sentences in each part of the lifecycle.
