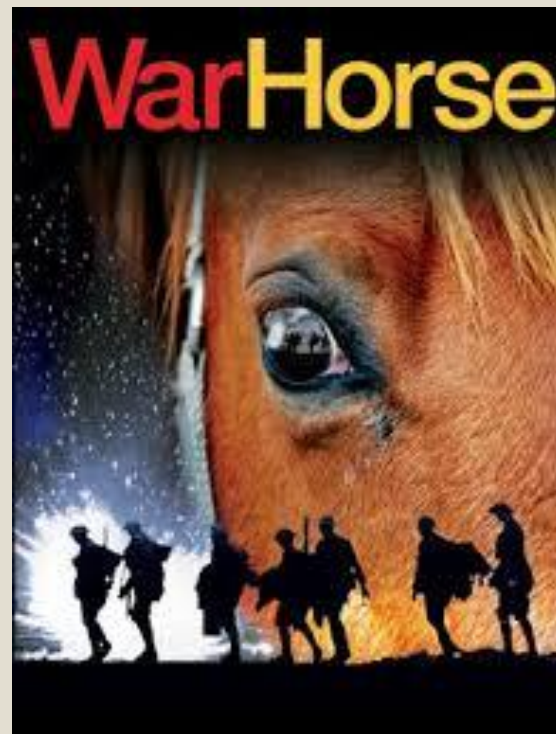

We are learning about the two World wars this term, in the first half of the term we are looking at life in the Trenches, reading Archie's War and War Horse. After half-term we will then move to World War 2 and will be reading 'Carrie's War', which will introduce us to the time of children in evacuation.
