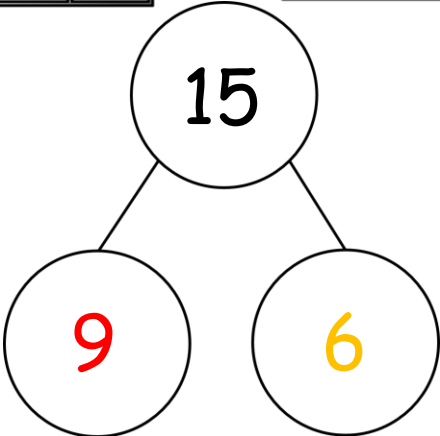

$$9 = 15 - 6$$

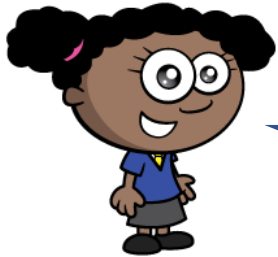

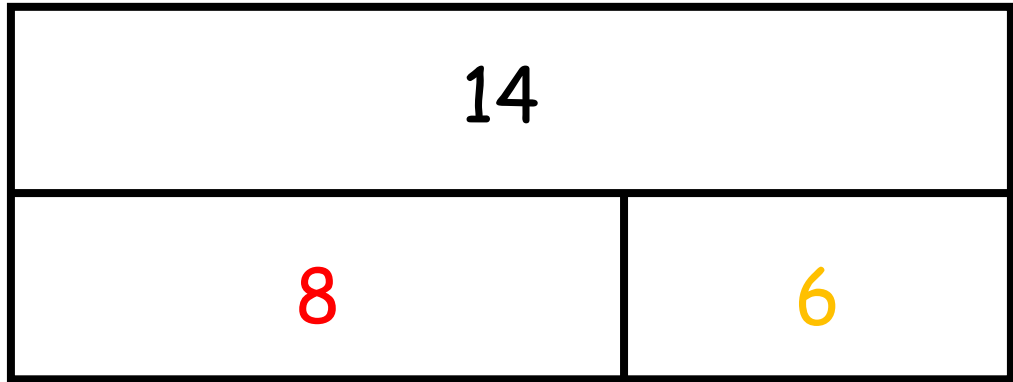

$$6 + 8 = 14$$

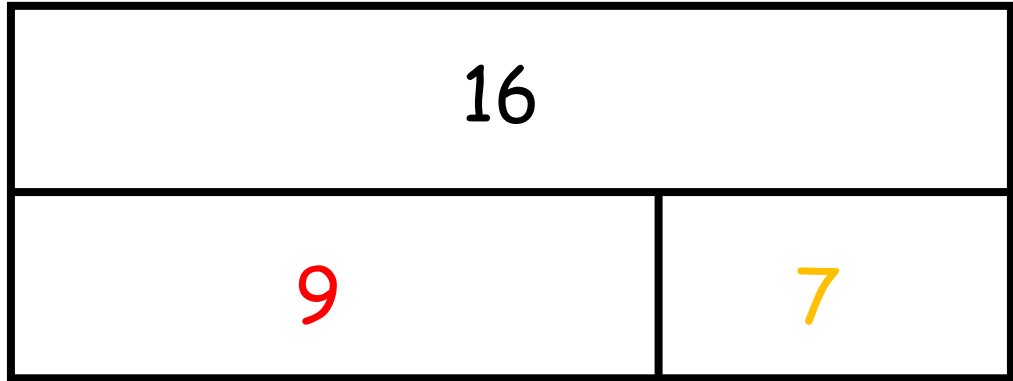
$$14 - 8 = 6$$
