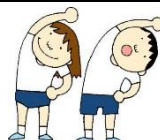

We work closely with parents and the team around the family to ensure we have a holistic approach to inclusion. We use external support from the local authority and the NHS to ensure all children's needs are understood and recommendations are followed by all. We meet termly with parents to produce One Plans which provide a personalised plan of short-term targets which allow us to follow a cycle of plan, assess, do, review to ensure timely intervention. In some cases, the need for additional provision is necessary to meet more complex needs and we may choose to apply for an education and health care plan (EHCP). Our whole community can access support from the Local Offer and parents can seek external support with SEN from the team at
